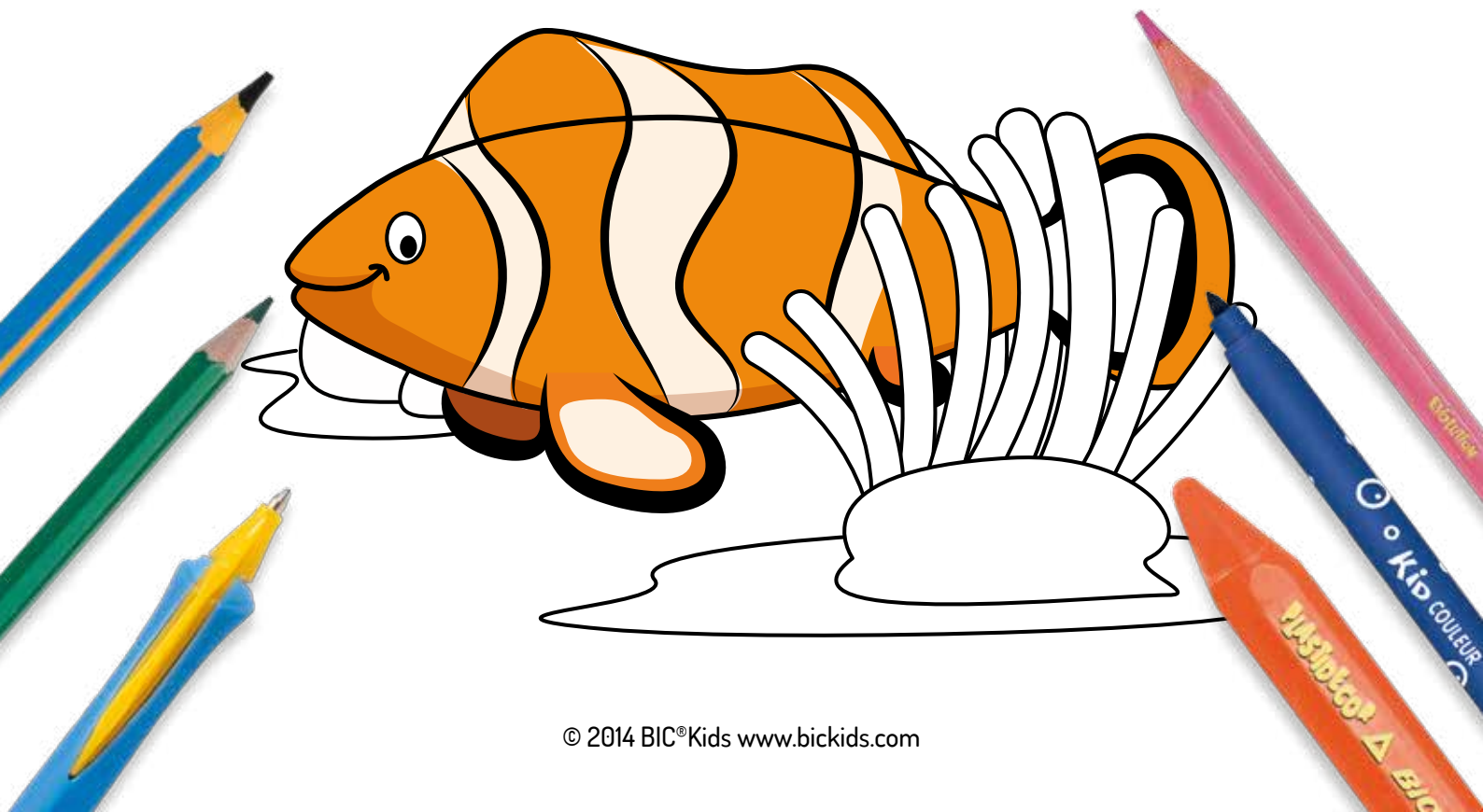

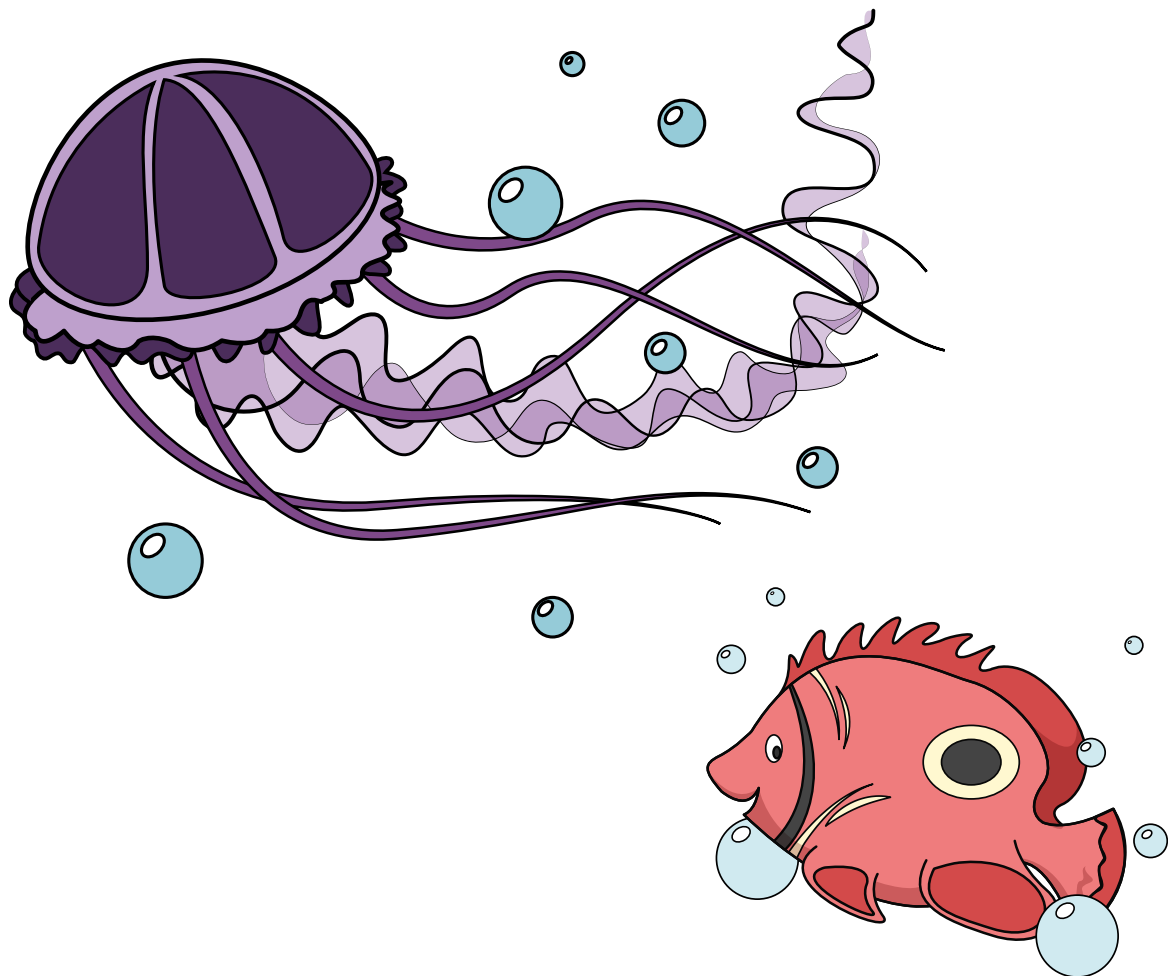
Sea creatures

Do you know the names of some sea creatures?



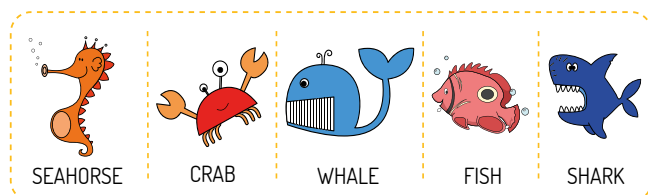
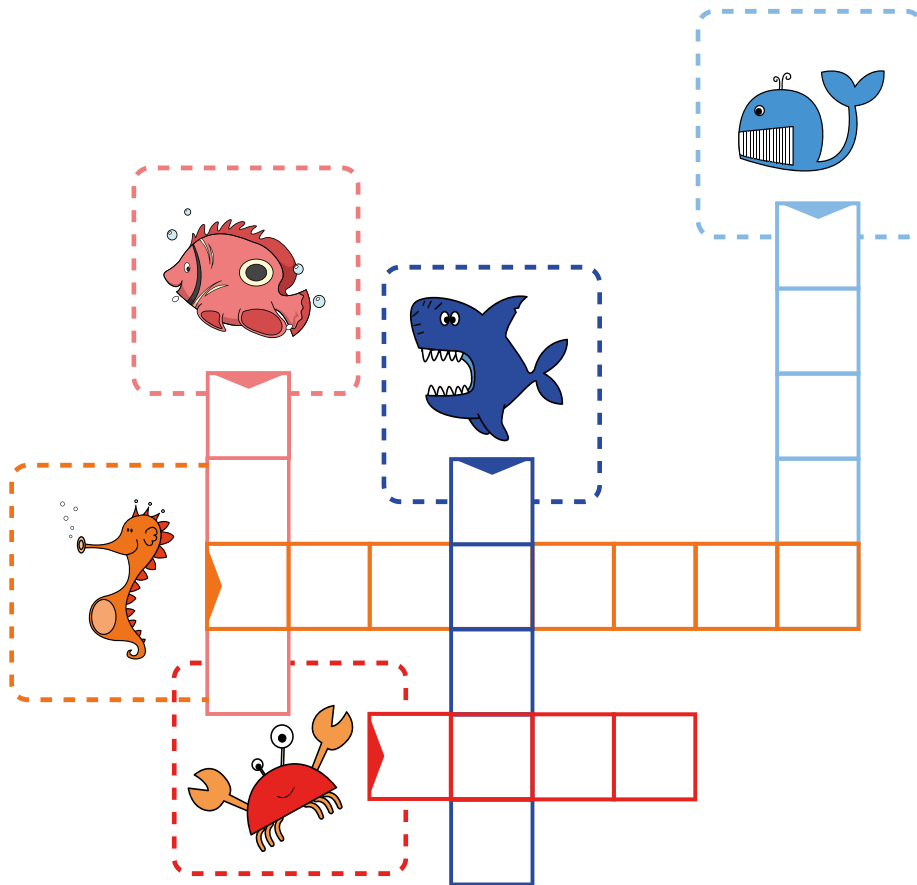

How many teeth does the whale have altogether?



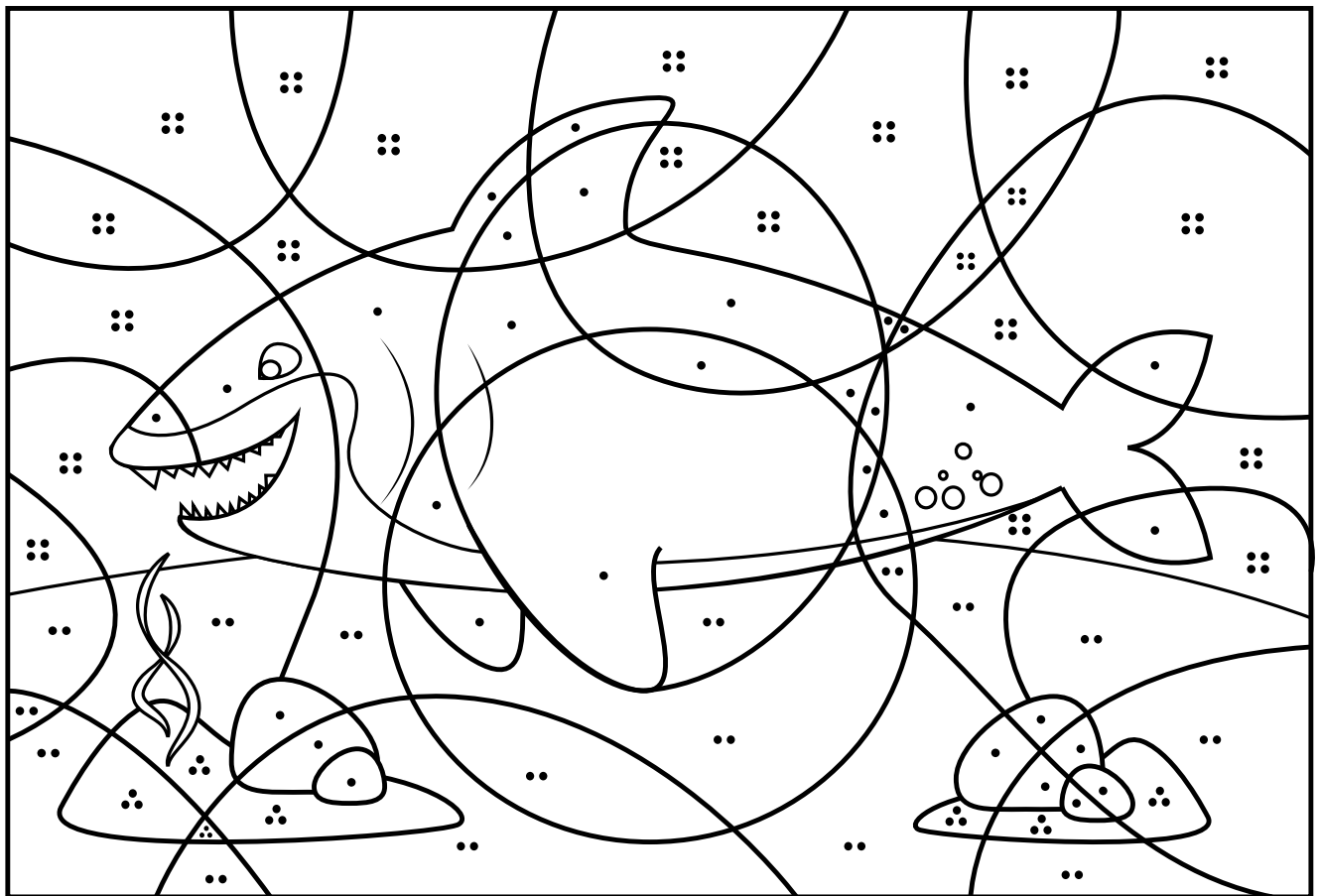

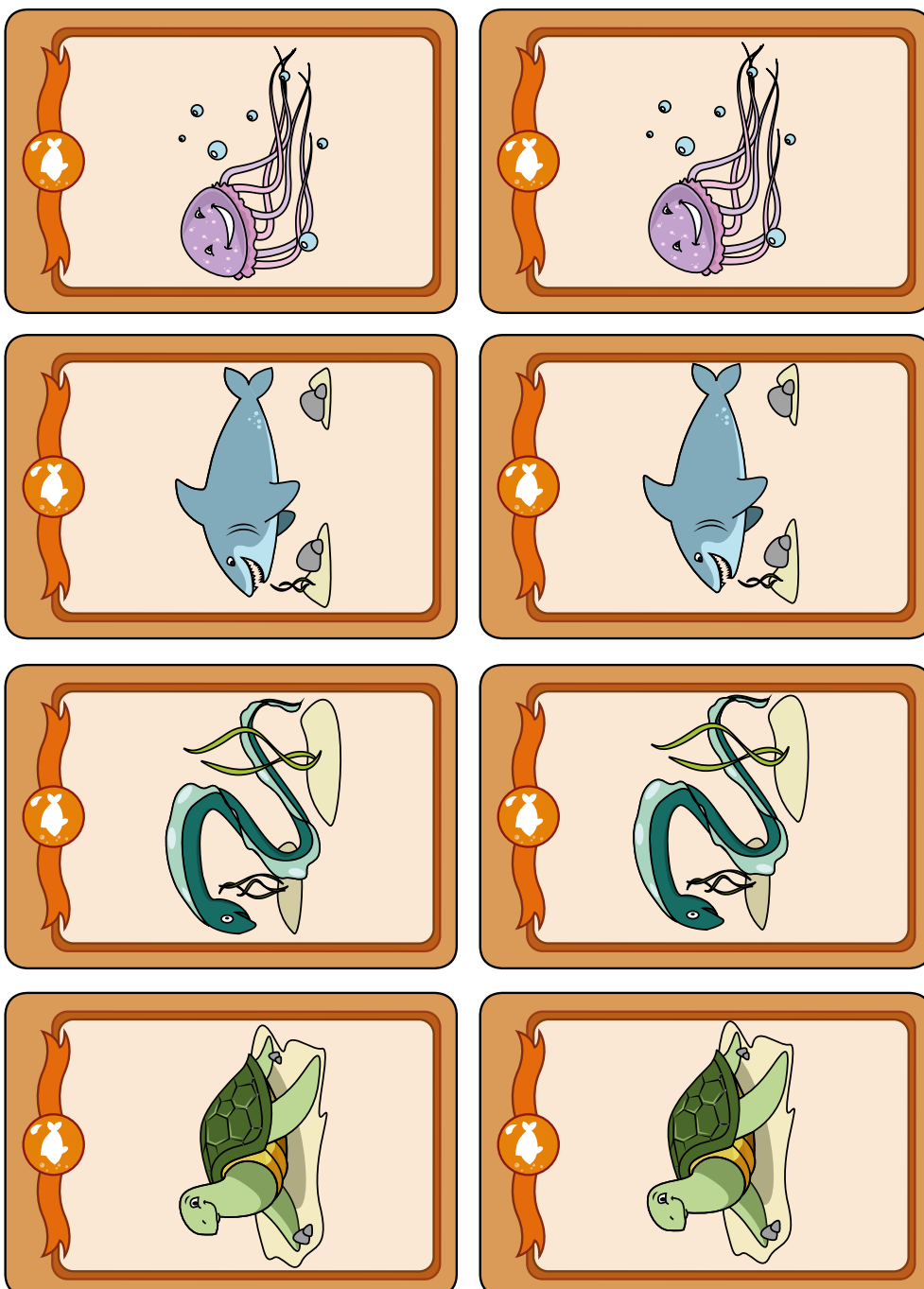


Train your memory

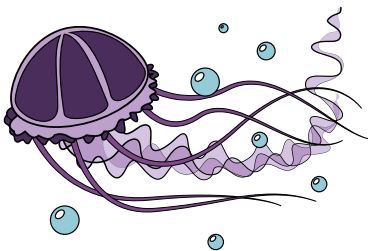

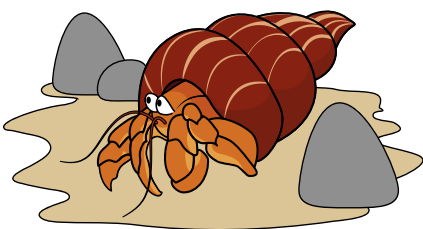
